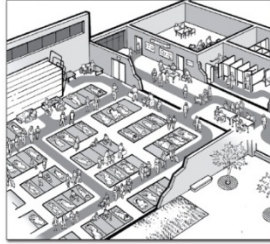


## Upcoming Webinar

### How to set up an Inclusive Shelter Exercise

#### Webinar Overview:

Marilyn Self will discuss the Red Cross program in Georgia where they work collaboratively with Disability Advocacy groups to increase capacity to meet the access and functional needs of shelter residents. She will also cover the planning aspects for exercises that are inclusive and meet the needs of the whole community.

Dawn Brantley, former Emergency Programs Manager for the Anchorage Office of Emergency Management will describe Anchorage, Alaska's shelter exercise which included the set-up of Functional Needs Shelter and Support (FNSS) equipment, public volunteers sleeping overnight in the shelter, educational programming for the participants, and a FANS (Functional and Access Needs Support) Team volunteer program.
